## DAY 01: SINGAPORE

Assemble at Changi International Airport to check-in for your flight to **Beijing**, China.

## DAY 02: SINGAPORE - BEIJING

(Lunch, Peking Roast Duck Dinner)

Welcome on board Singapore Airlines flight to Beijing the capital city of China. ## DAY 5: BEIJING

Today's highlight is the magnificent **Great Wall of China** (Badaling section). The Great Wall was a massive defenses project that represented the wisdom and tenacity of the ancient Chinese. This ancient Chinese structure, stretching over 6000km of mountain terrain is one of the few visible man-made structures from the moon. Proceed to visit **Ming Tomb** where 13 Ming Dynasty emperors were buried. It is also listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Be entertained with a **cultural show** while you have your dinner at **Daijaican Restaurant**.

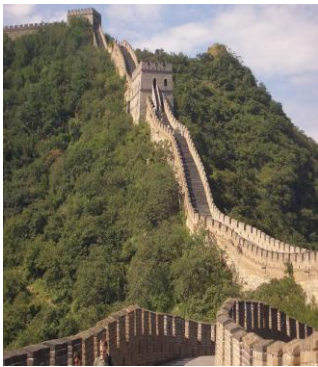
## DAY 06: BEIJING - XIAN

**City Wall Park** where you may wish to join some local citizen doing exercises. In the evening, go to the **Big Wild Goose Square** and watch the Musical Fountain Performance.

**DAY 07: XIAN**

(Breakfast, Shaanxi Lunch, Dinner)

Today, visit the famous **Terra-cotta Burial Site**, an incredible home to 8,000 life like Terra-cotta soldiers it was declared as world cultural heritage by UNESCO. Next, proceed to a local workshop for a lesson on the making of the **miniature of Terra-Cotta Warriors**. Visit the ancient **Banpo Village**, which houses a 6,000 BC year old village that belonged to the Neolithic clan community.

**DAY 8: XIAN – SHANGHAI**

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Depart on a **domestic flight to Shanghai**. Upon arrival, visit the splendid **Yu Garden**, considered one of the most lavish and finest Chinese gardens in the region. Next, stop at **The Bund**, one of the most recognizable architectural symbols of Shanghai.

**DAY 9: SHANGHAI**

Take a **leisurely boat cruise on the Huangpu River**. Visit **Qibao Ancient Town**.
